For the purpose of inducing Fidelity to act upon my instructions, I do fully indemnify and hold harmless Fidelity Distributors Corporation, Fidelity Brokerage Services LLC, National Financial Services LLC, Fidelity Service Company, Inc., Fidelity Management Trust Company, and their affiliates, control persons, officers, directors, successors, assigns, and employees ("Fidelity") from and against any and all losses, liabilities, claims, and costs (including reasonable attorneys' fees) resulting from transactions made in accordance with my instructions; and
